AUTOMOTIVE EXPERTISE IN SPAIN

To become automotive expert some corresponding qualifications are necessary, current minimum required: Professional formation automotive grade II and take a course of 280 hours of theory and 40 hours of practice in the modality, which must contain the minimum materials program contained in the training program developed jointly by APCAS and UNESPA, which has also to be approved by the insurance Department of the Ministry of Economy and Finance.

One of the important activities of APCAS was the participation in the committee of the Spanish accreditation body "AENOR" AEN / CTN 197 "Reports of expert performances", whose mission has been to develop the standard UNE197001 regarding standardization of reports generally expert. Although the rule (**UNE19700**) refers to some general criteria to be applied in the expert reports, this rule does not indicate which technical system should be used but this rule will be very important in our sector and will improve with the time.
