## **AUTOMOTIVE EXPERTISE IN TURKEY**

TOBB (Turkiye Odalar ve Borsalar Birligi) (Union of Chambers and Commodity exchanges of Turkey) is a big confederation gathering many different sectors among which automotive experts. It is made of 1.5 million of members (small, middle and big-size businesses) split across 60 fields of activity. Its statutes are based on European laws governing chambers of commerce. The role of these chambers of commerce is to develop business zones, improve businesses, Research and Development.

Requirements for practice in Turkey :

- Requirements to become automotive expert : a 2-year training in university, a preselection examination, a 3-month internship in expertise followed by a new examination and finally 6 months of internship in expertise.
- The expertise market gathers 200 expertise consultancies and 1000 selfemployed automotive experts. Minimum fees for expertise : 34€
- Time limit to provide an assessment for claims in liability: 7 days. For claims related to comprehensive insurance: 15 days
- The expertise on the premises is compulsory in Turkey; Remote expertise is not developed for the moment.
